### Lesson Information:

Specialist teachers provide weekly 30 minute individual and small group lessons during school time (8 lessons per term). Lesson times are rotated weekly to ensure minimal absence from any one class.

Our staff are all highly experienced musicians and specialist teachers who are actively working in the industry. Our aim is to provide a comprehensive and enriching music program at CLTC which promotes musicianship, confidence and expression through supporting and mentoring students with a passion for music.

### Performances:

CLTC holds two official yearly concerts, with many other performance opportunities available to students including assemblies, school events and involvement in school bands/ensembles.

### Fees:

CLTC is proud to provide quality music lessons to students for at an **extremely low cost**. At **\$100** for the entire year of tuition, CLTC can provide a learning environment that may cost up to **\$30 per lesson** at a private music school. These costs cover tutoring, photocopying and minor repairs to instruments. We also offer instrument hire at \$40 for the year if needed, students learning drums will be provided drumsticks through the school.

### Requirements:

A deposit of \$20 is required before the commencement of lessons.

Full payment will be required by the 5<sup>th</sup> Lesson.

Year 4/6 students are picked up directly from class by the teacher, and it is the responsibility of secondary students to attend all scheduled classes on time.

Materials such as a USB stick/ folder may be required for the teacher to provide the student with materials for practice.

**CLTC INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC**

Participating in Instrumental Music is an exciting opportunity offered to students in Years 4-12.

**CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC LESSONS ARE AVAILABLE:**

1. The student's work will be subject to report and assessment, as is work in all other school subjects.
2. One lesson per week is given during school hours, the student being withdrawn from class at a time which rotates throughout the school day so that the same subject is not missed each week.
3. Each student must practice regularly and consistently. Full parental support is required.
4. Students are expected to participate in regular ensemble (group/band) rehearsals and performances throughout the year.
5. Payment of charges and hire fees if applicable must be made or lessons will cease.
6. Your email will be used for communication including absence.
