Essential Education Items (Curriculum)

The school receives some funding directly from the Government for Curriculum program support. However, this funding does not cover the costs of:

- General classroom needs: paper, pencils, activity books, printing, photocopying, resource materials, visual art supplies, food technology supplies.
- e/Learning: iPads, applications, ICT support.
- Student ID Cards.

Excursion Levy

Excursion payments are now incorporated into the annual charges. The Excursion Levy will replace all incursion/excursion payments throughout the year. The levy will not go towards camps, swimming program, interschool sport or instrumental music. These items will be charged separately.

CSEF (Camps, Sports, Excursion Funding).

Families with a Centrelink Healthcare Card may be eligible to receive \$125.00. This funding can be used to cover all the Excursion levy (\$75.00). Any unused CSEF funding can be used towards Camps, Swimming Program, Interschool Sports, Instrumental Music or any other activity.

New families to Charles La Trobe College will need to fill out an application form, available from the school office. Current students receiving the funding, do not need to re-apply.
